We took the step in 2019 to not mules the Bundilla stud lambs and use the Te Pari tail docking iron.

We had a number of trial groups for tail length, and found that docking at the 2nd palpable joint was the most successful result. We have scored all of the ewe and ram lambs at 12 months for Breech Wrinkle (BWR), Breech Cover (BCOV) and Dag score (DAG).

These rams and ewes have been run on canola and wheat grazing crops since March which was a good test on the success of non-mules through dag score.

2021 Bundilla Sires

We believe the Bundilla genetic base is one of the most balanced high performing flocks in the industry and this is constantly proven in Sire Evaluations over the past 10 years. So to answer this question we aim to have the most productive balanced high performing merino genetics in the industry.

The twenty five 2019 drop Bundilla Stud reserves that we have kept this year are an outstanding group of young rams. We are often asked where we are trying to take the Bundilla genetics over the next 10 years. We find this one of the hardest questions to answer, because we are not trying to have extreme animals for any one trait we are looking to build our bloodline across all traits which we believe drive the profitability of our clients breeding programs.

Below are the average ASBV results for the 25 young rams we have kept to join in the stud in 2021 & what percentile band they sit within the merino industry. We are proud of the results of this group because of how balanced they are across all traits.
